

# **Biblical Prophecy Analysis - A Deep Dive October 13th, 2025**

## Appendix A: Detailed Scripture Cross-Reference

### The 70 Weeks Prophecy - Daniel 9:24-27 (Complete Context)

Daniel 9:24 - "Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sin, to make atonement for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy and to anoint the most holy place."

Daniel 9:25 - "So you are to know and discern that from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince there will be seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress."

Daniel 9:26 - "Then after the sixty-two weeks the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. And its end will come with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined."

Daniel 9:27 - "And he will make a firm covenant with the many for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of abominations will come one who makes desolate, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on the one who makes desolate."

### The 3.5 Year Periods in Scripture

#### 1. Daniel's "Time, Times, and Half a Time"

- Daniel 7:25 - Authority given for "time, times, and half a time"
- Daniel 12:7 - "time, times, and half a time" until end
- Revelation 12:14 - Woman protected for "time, times, and half a time"

#### 2. Revelation's "42 Months"

- Revelation 11:2 - Nations tread Jerusalem for 42 months
- Revelation 13:5 - Beast given authority for 42 months

#### 3. Revelation's "1,260 Days"

- Revelation 11:3 - Two witnesses prophesy 1,260 days
- Revelation 12:6 - Woman in wilderness 1,260 days

### Mathematical Proof:

- 1 time + 2 times + 1/2 time = 3.5 times (years)

- 42 months = 3.5 years
- 1,260 days ÷ 360-day prophetic year = 3.5 years
- All refer to the same 3.5-year period

## The Abomination of Desolation References

Daniel 9:27 - "On the wing of abominations will come one who makes desolate"

Daniel 11:31 - "Forces from him will arise, desecrate the sanctuary fortress, and do away with the regular sacrifice. And they will set up the abomination of desolation."

Daniel 12:11 - "From the time that the regular sacrifice is abolished and the abomination of desolation is set up, there will be 1,290 days."

Matthew 24:15 - "Therefore when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION which was spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place (let the reader understand)"

Mark 13:14 - "But when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION standing where it should not be (let the reader understand), then those who are in Judea must flee to the mountains."

2 Thessalonians 2:3-4 - "Let no one in any way deceive you, for it will not come unless the apostasy comes first, and the man of lawlessness is revealed, the son of destruction, who opposes and exalts himself above every so-called god or object of worship, so that he takes his seat in the temple of God, displaying himself as being God."

## Israel Dwelling Securely - Ezekiel 38

Ezekiel 38:8 - "After many days you will be summoned; in the latter years you will come into the land that is restored from the sword, whose inhabitants have been gathered from many nations to the mountains of Israel which had been a continual waste; but its people were brought out from the nations, and they are living securely, all of them."

Ezekiel 38:11 - "and you will say, 'I will go up against the land of unwalled villages. I will go against those who are at rest, that live securely, all of them living without walls and having no bars or gates'"

Ezekiel 38:14 - "Therefore prophesy, son of man, and say to Gog, 'Thus says the Lord GOD, "On that day when My people Israel are living securely, will you not know it?"'"

Current Application: The October 13, 2025 peace agreement creates conditions where Israel will be "dwelling securely" - precisely the scenario Ezekiel describes before the Gog-Magog invasion.

## Peace and Safety - 1 Thessalonians 5:1-3

1 Thessalonians 5:1-3 - “Now as to the times and the epochs, brethren, you have no need of anything to be written to you. For you yourselves know full well that the day of the Lord will come just like a thief in the night. While they are saying, ‘Peace and safety!’ then destruction will come upon them suddenly like labor pains upon a woman with child, and they will not escape.”

Current Application: Trump’s declarations on October 13, 2025:

- “The war is over”
- “Peace in the Middle East”
- “Finally at peace”
- “The guns are silent”

This matches the “peace and safety” proclamation that precedes sudden destruction.

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## Appendix B: The Third Temple - The Truth That Changes Everything

### The Massive Misconception

For decades, prophecy teachers have said: “The Third Temple must be built, and that will take many years.” This teaching has given millions of people a false sense of security—a belief that we have time before the Tribulation can begin.

This teaching is based on a critical misunderstanding.

### What Scripture Actually Requires

The Bible does NOT require a massive stone building like Solomon’s Temple or Herod’s Temple.

What Scripture describes is THE TABERNACLE OF DAVID—a tent structure, similar to what Moses built in the wilderness and David erected in Jerusalem.

The Hebrew word used is “sukkah” (סֻכָּה) = booth, tent, tabernacle—NOT a permanent stone temple building.

Historical Precedent: David’s Tabernacle

2 Samuel 6:17 - “So they brought in the ark of the LORD and set it in its place inside the tent which David had pitched for it; and David offered burnt offerings and peace offerings before the LORD.”

David erected a TENT on Mount Zion where:

- The Ark of the Covenant was placed
- Sacrifices were offered
- Worship occurred continuously
- It stood for approximately 33 years until Solomon’s Temple was completed

This was legitimate worship in God’s eyes—in a tent, not a building.

Why This Changes EVERYTHING

A stone temple would require:

- Removal of Dome of the Rock (triggering World War III)
- Years of construction
- Massive international crisis
- Seemingly impossible political solution

A tent tabernacle requires:

- Permission to erect it (could be part of peace covenant)

- Something to "stop" at the midpoint

A tent tabernacle fulfills ALL these requirements.

It does NOT require:

A massive building  
Years of construction  
Removal of Islamic structures  
A replica of Solomon's Temple

The Abomination of Desolation in a Tent

Matthew 24:15 - "Therefore when you see the ABOMINATION OF DESOLATION which was spoken of through Daniel the prophet, standing in the holy place..."

2 Thessalonians 2:4 - "So that he takes his seat in the temple of God, displaying himself as being God."

The "holy place" and "temple of God" can be:

- The Holy of Holies in the Tabernacle
- The inner chamber where God's presence dwells
- NOT necessarily a stone building

When the Antichrist enters the Holy Place at midpoint:

- He stops the sacrifices occurring in the Tabernacle
- He enters the sacred tent
- He declares himself God in that space
- He sets up the abomination (possibly an image of himself)

This works perfectly with a tent structure.

WEEKS/MONTHS LATER: Permission Granted

- As part of implementing peace agreement
- Israel given authorization to erect Tabernacle
- Seen as religious freedom and tolerance
- World applauds "shared Jerusalem"

#### DAYS/WEEKS AFTER PERMISSION:

- Red Heifer sacrificed
- Priests purified
- Tabernacle erected
- Implements moved in
- Consecration ceremony
- DAILY SACRIFICES BEGIN
- THE 70TH WEEK OFFICIALLY STARTS

#### 3.5 YEARS LATER:

- Antichrist enters the Tabernacle
- Stops the sacrifices
- Declares himself God
- Second half of Tribulation begins

#### Why This Demands Urgent Attention

If temple worship can begin in days or weeks rather than years, then:

##### 1. The timeline is compressed dramatically
