The Rapture was not a secret for those who were watching and ready. But for many — maybe for you — the warnings were dismissed, delayed, or drowned out by the noise of this world. You may have believed in Jesus, but only in part. You may have worn the name "Christian" without surrendering to Christ's lordship. You may have been lukewarm — loving the world enough to be accepted by it, but not loving Jesus enough to suffer for Him.

And now the Great Tribulation has begun.

The World You Are Now In

According to the visions given in the Azovmena Prophecies, we are now in the most catastrophic period in human history. World War III has erupted. Nuclear fire has consumed cities. Nations reel under judgment for rejecting God's covenant. The Antichrist has risen, offering false peace while preparing global enslavement.

The persecution of all who turn to Jesus has begun — and it will only intensify. The Beast system is already building the technology and laws to control every purchase, every movement, every breath. Soon you will be told to take the Mark — a digital seal binding you to the Antichrist's rule — or face imprisonment, starvation, or death.

"And he causes all, the small and the great, the rich and the poor, and the free men and the slaves, to be given a mark on their right hand or on their forehead, and he provides that no one will be able to

buy or to sell, except the one who has the mark, either the name of the beast or the number of his name." — Revelation 13:16-17

Do not take it. Not under any circumstances. It will seal your eternal damnation.

Why This Book Exists

Before the Rapture, THE Grace Awakening was written to awaken believers to the fullness of God's grace — to live in His power, peace, and purpose while there was still time. Now, this post-Rapture edition is for you, the one left behind, to tell you there is still time to be saved, but not from the Tribulation — from eternal separation from God.

This is your survival manual for both body and soul:

- To endure to the end if God preserves your life until Christ's return at Armageddon.
- To remain faithful unto death if He calls you to martyrdom for the sake of His Name.

And for some of you, this book will be the map to a physical refuge — an ALFC Grace Home in the Great Basin Region. These homes are small, hidden communities of Christ-followers, living as the early Church did in Acts 2 — sharing all things, breaking bread, discipling one another, and preparing for whatever the next day brings. In this place, you will learn not only how to survive but how to die well if called upon, holding fast to Jesus until your last breath.

The Road Ahead

The coming pages will teach you how to:

1. Repent immediately and receive the grace of God that still flows, even now.
2. Refuse the Mark of the Beast no matter the cost.
3. Live in the Grace Space — that unshakable place of trust in God's goodness, even when the world burns.
4. Disciple others in secret, under threat of death, using only the Word hidden in your heart.
5. Face persecution with courage, love, and the hope of Christ's imminent return.

The cost will be everything you have left. But what you gain is everything that will never be taken away.

"Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life." — Revelation 2:10

The Rapture is past. The Tribulation is here. The King is still coming. There is no more middle ground. Choose Him now, live for Him now, die for Him if you must — but whatever you do, do not deny Him.

This is your awakening. This is your last chance.

Chapter 1: Grace in the Great Tribulation — The Last Invitation

You may think the door of grace slammed shut when the Rapture happened — that God's mercy was over, the invitation withdrawn, and the verdict final. You are right in one sense: the Age of the Church as you knew it is over. The Bride has been taken. The "Philadelphia Church" — the faithful remnant — has escaped the hour of testing (Revelation 3:10).

But here is the miracle: the grace of God has not been withdrawn. It flows still, but now only for those who will receive it at the cost of everything in this life.

"The one who comes to Me I will certainly not cast out." — John 6:37

Grace is God's unearned, unbreakable, undeserved favor — not a soft blanket to cover your sin, but a lifeline that pulls you out of the pit and plants you in His Kingdom. Grace is still offered to you now. But in these days, it will be resisted with every force of Hell and every power of the Antichrist's Beast system.

The Last Invitation

Right now, in the chaos, in the aftermath, in the smoke of nuclear fire and the roar of lawless mobs, the Spirit of God is still calling: "Come to Me."

The Azovmena Prophecy spoke of this — a massive revival after the Rapture, millions coming to Christ under the most extreme persecution the world has ever seen. This revival is not a tent meeting in the open air; it is whispered prayers in basements, baptisms in the dark, Bibles passed hand-to-hand under the threat of execution.

You who are reading this — you are being invited into that revival now.

"Seek the Lord while He may be found; Call upon Him while He is near." — Isaiah 55:6

Do not wait. Do not bargain for "a better time." The Beast system will not allow one. If you hear Him calling now, surrender everything now.

Living in the Grace Space When the World is Burning

Before the Rapture, I taught believers how to live in what I called the Grace Space — the place where you live fully aware of God's presence, dependent on His goodness, and free from self-effort religion. In the Tribulation, the Grace Space becomes your only shelter.

It is not a physical address. It is the unshakable reality that even if you are starving, hunted, or imprisoned, you are still in Christ, and nothing can snatch you from His hand (John 10:28).

The Grace Space will be the difference between those who curse God in their suffering and those who sing hymns on the way to execution. It is the place where Paul and Silas prayed and sang hymns in a Philippian jail (Acts 16:25). It is where Stephen saw heaven open as stones crushed his body (Acts 7:55-56).

And it is where you must live every day from now until you see Him face to face.

The Mark: Your Defining Choice

Make no mistake — in these days, there is no middle ground. The Mark of the Beast will be forced upon you as the only way to buy food, water, medicine, or fuel. It may come as a microchip, a biometric scan, or some other digital ID. It will be promoted as "safety," "unity," and "progress." But it is none of these. It is allegiance to the Antichrist.

"If anyone worships the beast and his image, and receives a mark on his forehead or on his hand, he also will drink of the wine of the wrath of God." — Revelation 14:9-10

You cannot take it and repent later. You cannot hide it from God. If you take it, you have chosen eternal damnation.

Refusing it will cost you everything in this life — but it will give you everything in the next.

Refuge in the Great Basin Region

In God's mercy, He has prepared physical places of refuge for some — like the Grace Homes in the Great Basin Region. These are small, Christ-centered communities operating in secrecy, patterned after Acts 2:42-47, where believers share resources, disciple one another, and prepare for whatever lies ahead.

If God leads you there, go quickly. If you cannot reach such a place, let your home become one — a secret place of prayer, fellowship, and endurance. But whether alone or with others, live as part of His Body. Isolation in these days is deadly to the soul.

The Azovmena Prophecy reminds us that God will preserve remnants — not all will fall to the Antichrist. Some of you reading this will be part of that remnant.

Your First Steps Right Now

1. Fall on your knees and repent — confess your sin, your unbelief, your compromise, and ask Jesus to cleanse you by His blood.
2. Surrender your life completely — no holding back. Decide now that you will follow Him to the death if necessary.
3. Memorize the Word — Bibles will be confiscated; hide His truth in your heart.

4. Find fellowship — even two or three gathered in His Name carry His presence (Matthew 18:20).

5. Prepare for hardship — store what you can, but trust God for what you cannot store.

"Here is the perseverance of the saints who keep the commandments of God and their faith in Jesus."

— Revelation 14:12

This is your last invitation. Grace is still here. The King is still coming. And the time is shorter than you think.

Chapter 2: Enduring to the End — The Path of the Martyr and the Remnant

"But the one who endures to the end, he will be saved." — Matthew 24:13

You now stand at the narrowest point of history — where your faith in Christ will be tested to the limit. In the Great Tribulation, enduring to the end is not a theological debate. It is your daily reality. It will cost you everything: your possessions, your freedom, and likely your life.

Every true believer left after the Rapture will walk one of two paths:

1. **The Path of the Martyr** — executed for refusing the Mark of the Beast, giving your life in exchange for eternal glory.
2. **The Path of the Remnant** — hidden by God's hand, preserved until Christ's visible return at Armageddon.

Both paths require the same commitment: to live and die in Christ, without compromise.

The Path of the Martyr

The book of Revelation speaks plainly:

"I saw the souls of those who had been beheaded because of their testimony of Jesus and because of the word of God, and those who had not worshiped the beast or his image, and had not received the mark on their forehead and on their hand; and they came to life and reigned with Christ for a thousand years." — Revelation 20:4

Martyrdom in these days will not be a random act of violence. It will be an official punishment for refusing the Beast's allegiance. It may be beheading, shooting, burning, or some other public execution. The Antichrist will use these deaths to terrorize the world — but to Heaven, they are precious.

"Precious in the sight of the Lord is the death of His godly ones." — Psalm 116:15

If God calls you to this path, do not fear. In that moment, the Holy Spirit will give you the words to speak and the courage to stand. You will close your eyes in this world and open them to the face of the King.

The Path of the Remnant

The Azovmena Prophecy tells of remnants preserved across the earth — hidden pockets of believers who will survive to greet Christ at His return. Some will be in the Carpathian Mountains, some in the Alps, some in remote areas of Africa and Asia. In North America, the Great Basin Region will be one such refuge, where ALFC Grace Homes will serve as fortified spiritual families.

The Remnant's mission is to:

- Preserve the Word of God in secret.
- Disciple new believers who come to Christ during the Tribulation.
- Share food, water, and shelter without bowing to the Beast system.
- Remain faithful witnesses until the skies split and the King appears in glory.

Survival will require prayer-led movement, deep community trust, and constant dependence on God's provision. But the same grace that empowers a martyr to die will empower a remnant to endure.

The Discipline of Endurance

Endurance in the Tribulation is not passive waiting; it is active faith under fire. To endure is to:

- Fix your eyes on the return of Christ — never let your hope drift to politics, survivalism, or earthly rescue.
- Live as if every day is your last — love deeply, forgive quickly, speak truth boldly.

The enemy will try to seduce you with lies:

- "You can take it and repent later." (You cannot — Revelation 14:9-11)
- "God will understand." (He will not excuse idolatry — Exodus 20:3-5)
- "Think of your family." (Eternity is worth more than temporary survival)

The Grace of God will hold you if you set your heart in advance — I will not bow.

The Great Basin Covenant

If God has brought you to an ALFC Grace Home in the Great Basin, you are part of a covenant community. Here, every member agrees to:

1. Stand for Christ without compromise.
2. Share all resources as one family.
3. Protect one another as the Body of Christ.
4. Disciple the next generation in secret.
5. Prepare hearts for either preservation or martyrdom.

This is not a place for spectators or half-hearts. In the days ahead, betrayal will come even from family members (Matthew 10:21). Your loyalty must be to Christ and to His people above all else.

The Promise of the Crown

Whether you die as a martyr or endure as a remnant, the promise is the same:

"Be faithful until death, and I will give you the crown of life." — Revelation 2:10

The Beast's rule will end. Christ's Kingdom will never end. Your suffering is temporary; your reward is eternal. Stand firm. Endure to the end. And remember — the King is coming.

Chapter 3: Discipleship Underground — Making Disciples When It's Illegal

"Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and the Son and the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." — Matthew 28:19-20

The command to make disciples did not vanish with the Rapture. It has not been suspended in the Great Tribulation. In fact, the urgency has never been greater. The world is under the deception of the Antichrist; truth is outlawed; preaching Christ can cost you your head — and yet, Jesus still says: "Go."

Why Discipleship Still Matters Now

In these days, discipleship is not an optional ministry program. It is survival.

- **For you** — you will not last long in isolation. You need the prayers, encouragement, and correction of other believers.
- **For others** — those who come to faith in the Tribulation are spiritual infants in the most hostile environment in history. Without discipleship, they will be devoured by deception.

Making disciples in the Great Tribulation is not about building large gatherings; it is about multiplying faithful witnesses one person at a time.

The Azovmena Example

The Azovmena Prophecy tells us that revival will break out in unexpected places, even under Antichrist rule. In Ukraine, it will happen through the Orthodox Church in the west; in the Great Basin Region, it will happen through hidden house fellowships like the ALFC Grace Homes.

The pattern is always the same: small, committed groups meeting in secret, discipling each other in the Word, sharing resources, and preparing to stand firm.

Principles of Underground Discipleship

1. **Keep It Small and Mobile** — Meet in groups of two to five. Change locations often. Avoid predictable patterns.
2. **Rely on Memory and Oral Teaching** — Physical Bibles will be rare and dangerous to carry. Memorize Scripture, tell the stories aloud, and teach others to pass them on word-for-word.
3. **Focus on Obedience, Not Information** — In normal times, people collect teachings without applying them. Here, every truth must be obeyed immediately. Knowledge without obedience is a death trap.
4. **Multiply Leaders Quickly** — Everyone you disciple should be equipped to disciple others within weeks, not years. Time is short; the Beast's grip is tightening daily.
5. **Teach Spiritual Disciplines for Endurance** — Prayer, fasting, worship, forgiveness, and love for enemies are not "extras" — they are survival skills in the Kingdom.

The ALFC Grace Home Model

If you find refuge in a Great Basin Grace Home, you will experience discipleship as a lifestyle, not a class. In these homes:

- Meals become moments of teaching.
- Work projects become training grounds for humility, cooperation, and trust.
- Prayer watches run day and night, dividing the burden among the community.
- Every person is both a disciple and a disciple-maker.

If you cannot reach a Grace Home, adopt the model wherever you are — even in a prison cell or a refugee camp.

Evangelism Under the Beast

Public preaching is suicide in this system — but personal witness still works. Whisper the Gospel to the desperate. Leave Scripture notes where they can be found. Pray for the sick in secret. Let your courage in refusing the Mark spark curiosity in those watching.

Remember: God is not limited by the Antichrist's laws. His Spirit moves where He wills, and His Word cannot be chained (2 Timothy 2:9).

Guard Against Betrayal

Jesus warned that in these days, betrayal will come even from family (Matthew 10:21). Choose carefully whom you trust. Test every profession of faith by fruit, not words. Share meeting times and locations only with those who have proven faithfulness.

Train for Either Path

In discipleship now, you must prepare people for both outcomes:

- Living to see Christ's return as part of the Remnant.
- Dying in faith as a martyr.

Teach both as victories. The goal is not to preserve life at all costs — it is to be faithful unto death, in whatever way God calls.

"For to me, to live is Christ and to die is gain." — Philippians 1:21

The Final Fruit of Underground Discipleship

When Christ returns at the end of the Tribulation, He will not be looking for who built the largest underground network or who survived the longest. He will be looking for faithfulness.

The fruit of your labor will be standing beside you — men, women, and children who refused the Mark, endured persecution, and now shine with the glory of the Lamb.

This is why you disciple in secret. This is why you risk everything. And this is why, even in the shadow of death, you will keep going until the end.

Chapter 4: Life in the Great Basin Grace Homes — The Covenant of Refuge

"They were continually devoting themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer... And the Lord was adding to their number day by day those who were being saved." — Acts 2:42, 47

The Great Basin Region will be one of God's preserved pockets during the Great Tribulation — not free from danger, but set apart for His purposes. The Azovmena Prophecy confirms that remnants will survive in specific geographic areas to greet Christ at His return. In North America, these will include small, hidden networks of believers living as the early Church did: in homes, under covenant, in constant discipleship, and prepared for persecution.

These are the Grace Homes of ALFC (Abundant Life Family Care).

Why the Great Basin?

Geographically, the Great Basin is isolated by mountains and desert, making it harder for Beast-system forces to control completely. Spiritually, it has been prepared in advance — believers before the Rapture laid the groundwork for hidden, self-sustaining communities.

Some homes will be tucked into rural valleys, others in quiet neighborhoods hiding in plain sight. All will share the same covenant: to live in Christ-centered unity, survive together, and stand as witnesses until the end.

The Covenant of Refuge

Every Grace Home operates by a covenant built on five pillars:

1. **Christ is King** — We bow to no one but Jesus Christ.
2. **Total Sharing** — All resources are held in common for the good of the Body.
3. **Mutual Protection** — We watch over each other spiritually and physically.
4. **Constant Discipleship** — Every member grows as both disciple and disciple-maker.

1. **Morning Watch** — The day begins with Scripture reading, prayer, and worship — quietly, often in whispers if under surveillance. These moments anchor the day in God's presence.
2. **Shared Labor** — Food is grown, cooked, and preserved together. Security perimeters are checked. Repairs are made. Every task is an act of service to the Lord.

3. **Teaching in Circles** — Leaders rotate daily, teaching from memory or smuggled Scriptures. Children are trained alongside adults. Every lesson ends with immediate application.
4. **Prayer Watches** — Members take turns praying through the night, keeping both physical and spiritual watch.
5. **Meals as Ministry** — Every shared meal becomes a time of encouragement, confession, and planning for the next day.

Security and Secrecy

In the Tribulation, exposure means destruction. Grace Homes follow strict operational security:

- No open fires visible at night.
- No regular movement patterns.
- No unnecessary contact with outsiders.
- No public displays of gatherings or worship.

Every member must understand — secrecy is not cowardice. It is stewardship of the mission.

Discipleship as the Core

Grace Homes are not survival bunkers; they are disciple-making centers. Even under persecution, members continue to teach the Word, train in spiritual disciplines, and send out trusted individuals to quietly evangelize.

- **Endurance until His return** — knowing how to survive without the Beast system, navigate the terrain, and avoid detection.

- **Martyrdom** — knowing how to testify under interrogation, face execution with peace, and die blessing the Name of Jesus.

The Great Basin Family

Though individual Grace Homes will operate independently, they will be spiritually connected through prayer, occasional messenger exchanges, and shared mission goals. In God's timing, these scattered homes will be part of the remnant that welcomes the returning King.

In these communities, you will find both safety and sharpening — a place to be loved, corrected, equipped, and sent out in courage.

The Grace Homes are not the ultimate refuge. They are temporary shelters for your faith until you reach the true Refuge — the King Himself. Whether you remain here until He splits the skies or join Him through the gateway of martyrdom, remember:

"God is our refuge and strength, A very present help in trouble." — Psalm 46:1

Chapter 5: Resisting the Beast System — Economic, Technological, and Spiritual Warfare

"And he causes all, the small and the great, the rich and the poor, and the free men and the slaves, to be given a mark on their right hand or on their forehead, and he provides that no one will be able to buy or to sell, except the one who has the mark, either the name of the beast or the number of his name." — Revelation 13:16-17

The Antichrist's Beast system will be unlike any dictatorship in history. It will control not just governments and armies, but every financial transaction, every food source, every digital identity, and every movement. It will be powered by technology, enforced by law, and fueled by fear.

To survive without submitting to it, you will need to engage in economic, technological, and spiritual warfare every single day.

The Economic War — Living Outside the Mark

Once the Mark of the Beast is enforced, you will not be able to buy or sell without it. This means:

- No access to bank accounts or cash.
- No legal employment.
- No purchase of food, water, medicine, or shelter.

If you refuse the Mark, your survival will depend on:

1. **Barter and Trade** — Learn to trade skills, food, and items directly with other believers or sympathetic unbelievers.
2. **Self-Sufficiency** — Grow your own food, collect and purify water, preserve what you harvest.
3. **Resource Networks** — Form connections with other Grace Homes or underground believers who can exchange supplies without entering the Beast's economy.

- **Shelter Concealment** — Camouflage entrances, limit visible light at night, and mask heat signatures when possible.

The Azovmena Prophecy's remnant strategy was clear: survival depends on knowing when to move, when to hide, and when to appear invisible.

The Spiritual War — Living Untouched in Spirit

Within the Great Basin Grace Homes, resistance is both collective and spiritual:

- Shared underground storerooms stocked with essentials.
- Rotating security watches to monitor for enemy patrols.
- Evacuation drills in case of breach.
- Scripture memory as the foundation for every member.
- Oaths of mutual protection, even unto death.

These homes are not just shelters — they are training grounds for faithful resistance until Christ's return.

You will not suddenly find courage at the execution site if you are compromising in small things today. Boldness in death is forged in daily obedience:

1. **Settle the Issue** — Decide now that you will not deny Christ, no matter the cost.
2. **Live as if Already Dead** — The Antichrist can only take what you have already surrendered to God.
3. **Learn to Worship in Suffering** — Train your heart to praise Him when hungry, hunted, or hurting.
4. **Memorize Promises** — Hide Scriptures like Revelation 2:10 and Romans 8:35-39 deep in your mind.

The Moment of Capture

If you are discovered or betrayed, here is how to face it:

- **Pray Immediately** — Ask the Holy Spirit to give you words and peace (Luke 12:11-12).
- **Do Not Resist with Violence** — Your victory is in faithfulness, not force (Matthew 26:52-53).
- **Guard Your Words** — Do not endanger other believers by revealing locations or names.
- **Keep Your Witness** — Even in chains, speak the truth of the Gospel with gentleness and clarity.

The Interrogation Room

The Beast system will use psychological and physical torture to break your will. Remember:

- They can harm your body, but not your soul (Matthew 10:28).
- Jesus Himself will be with you in that room (Acts 23:11).
- Silence may be wiser than argument; let your peace and presence testify.

If offered release in exchange for worshipping the Beast, know that this is the ultimate test — the very moment for which you have been preparing.

At the Place of Execution

Your death will be staged as a warning to others. The enemy wants fear to spread; God wants faith to spread. In that final moment:

1. **Lift Your Eyes** — See beyond the executioner to the Lord standing at the right hand of God, as Stephen did (Acts 7:55-56).
2. **Speak Life** — Bless those killing you, just as Jesus and Stephen did.
3. **Hold to the End** — Do not curse, deny, or plead for your life. Let your final breath glorify the King.

"And they overcame him because of the blood of the Lamb and because of the word of their testimony, and they did not love their life even when faced with death." — Revelation 12:11

The Witness of Martyrdom

Every execution is also a sermon. Those watching will remember your peace, your forgiveness, your unshakable faith — and some will be drawn to Christ because of it.

The Azovmena Prophecy reminds us that in this period, revival will spring up even in the shadow of death. Your faithfulness may ignite the spark that saves others.

If You Are in a Grace Home

The ALFC Grace Home covenant prepares every member for the possibility of martyrdom:

- We practice Scripture recitation under duress.
- We rehearse how to give a brief, clear testimony in seconds.
- We pray over each other as if every gathering might be the last.

If one of us is taken, we do not shrink back — we take their place in the mission.

The Crown of Life

The moment your earthly life ends, you will awaken in the presence of the One for whom you died. He will wipe away every tear, heal every wound, and place on your head the crown of life.

"For momentary, light affliction is producing for us an eternal weight of glory far beyond all comparison." — 2 Corinthians 4:17

Dying well is not about a dramatic finish; it is about a faithful life that ends the same way it was lived — surrendered to Jesus Christ.

Chapter 7: The Return of the King — Living for the Day the Sky Splits Open

"Then I saw heaven opened, and behold, a white horse, and He who sat on it is called Faithful and True, and in righteousness He judges and wages war." — Revelation 19:11

There is a day coming — closer than you think — when the gray skies of Tribulation will be torn apart. You will see Him. Every nation will see Him. The Antichrist will be destroyed. From the moment Adam and Eve hid in the garden to the moment you opened this book in the Great Tribulation, God's grace has been flowing like a river — unbroken, unstoppable, eternal.

For of His fullness we have all received, and grace upon grace. For the Law was given through Moses; grace and truth were realized through Jesus Christ."

I learned that my rescue was not because I earned it — far from it. I was dead in sin, utterly helpless, but God's love broke through. "But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us," made me alive together with Christ even when I was dead inside. He raised me up and seated me with Jesus, all as a gift of grace. I contribute nothing to my salvation except the need for it. I am saved by grace through faith — God's undeserved gift — not by any works of mine. This truth dismantled my pride and freed me from the hell derived from the demand for performance.

Ephesians 2:4–9 "But God, being rich in mercy, because of His great love with which He loved us, even when we were dead in our transgressions, made us alive together with Christ (by grace you have been saved), and raised us up with Him, and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus. For by grace you have been saved through faith; and that not of yourselves, it is the gift of God; not as a result of works, so that no one may boast."

Jesus didn't just save me from something — He saved me for something. He delivered me from the domain of darkness and transferred me into His own Kingdom. In that moment, I went from orphaned and adrift to a son in my Father's house. I discovered that we, the believers, have become the very Body of Christ — the supernatural Temple of God. This Temple is not a building of brick and stone, but a living sanctuary "not made with human hands," built by God's Spirit dwelling in us. Together we are being fitted together into a holy dwelling place for the Lord, a house of living stones where His glory resides. This revelation ignites awe in me: God has chosen to make His home in us, His people.

Colossians 1:13 "For He rescued us from the domain of darkness, and transferred us to the kingdom of His beloved Son."

My Identity and Calling

My only qualification for leadership is my absolute lack of qualification. I have nothing to offer Him but my sins and failures. My track record was littered with moral failures and even financial ruin. I've been broken, betrayed, and beaten down by my own poor choices. I carry scars of deep hurt — many of them self-inflicted. By every human standard, I disqualified myself a long time ago. And yet, amazingly, God chose me and called me. He revels in using the weak and foolish things to shame the wise.

Romans 5:17–21 "For if by the transgression of the one, death reigned through the one, much more those who receive the abundance of grace and of the gift of righteousness will reign in life through the One, Jesus Christ... So then as through one transgression there resulted condemnation to all men, even so through one act of righteousness there resulted justification of life to all men. For as through the one man's disobedience the many were made sinners, even so through the obedience of the One the many will be made righteous. The Law came in so that the transgression would increase; but where sin increased, grace abounded all the more, so that, as sin reigned in death, even so grace would reign through righteousness to eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

The Story of Suffering

My KINGDOM Empowered journey has been marked not only by great successes but also profound suffering. Seven years ago, I vividly remember when I realized everything was about to change. I wasn't fearful; I was resolute. The Holy Spirit began opening my eyes through blockchain technology—

not just its economic potential but its divine implications. It was clear: God was about to dismantle and reconstruct everything I had built.

But amid the suffering, a divine revelation emerged. King Jesus taught me the beauty and mystery of suffering—its ability to spiritually transform us into His likeness. Without suffering, we cannot truly understand humility, and without humility, we cannot receive Grace.
